

doggie first aid kit

When we have pets at home, it's not always obvious that we should have first aid supplies on-hand to treat their potential wounds, in addition to our own supplies. Here is a list of items to help you supplement your home first aid kit for your furry friends:

1. Muzzle/triangular bandage (a hurt animal can be very dangerous if not muzzled)
2. E-collar (cone)
3. Rolls of gauze
4. Water-resistant cloth medical tape (the only kind of tape that will stick to fur)
5. Coban 3M Self-Adherent Wrap – Vet-wrap (this becomes the outside of the bandage that will hold it all together)
6. Nylons/pantyhose (a section of pantyhose will help keep head bandages in place)



TIP: Keep your pet first aid supplies in the same location as your own first aid supplies so you always know where to find them in case of emergency.
